

Documents required for submission of thesis. International Mention

1. [Application for submission with International Mention](#) duly completed and signed by the interested party **with proof of registration**.
2. A pdf file of the thesis. art of the doctoral thesis, at least the abstract and conclusions, must be written in one of the usual languages for scientific communication in the field of knowledge, other than any of the official languages in Spain. This rule does not apply when the stays, reports and experts come from a Spanish-speaking country.
3. Certificate of approval of the supervisor(s).
4. Certificate of the Academic Committee of the program approving the thesis.
 - a. If necessary, the Academic Committee will reflect in the authorization of the defense that the thesis has a favorable report from the Research Ethics Committee (CEI).
 - b. If the thesis is a compendium of articles, this circumstance must also be reflected in the authorization for the defense.
5. [Report](#) of the thesis supervisor with the approval of the Programme's Academic Committee reflecting the analysis of coincidences once the thesis has passed through the **Turnitin programme** (agreement of the Commission for Official Postgraduate and Doctoral Studies of 18/07/2019). If the thesis has been made by compendium of articles and all the articles have already been published, the coincidence analysis report is not required. Should any of the articles not have been published, the analysis should be performed on those parts of the work that have not been published.
6. A pdf document generated by the Turnitin application (this is the document that the doctoral student submits to the Programme).
7. Summary of the thesis in Word (approximately half a page) with the [UNESCO](#) codes assigned to the thesis.
8. Completed activities document including all the activities carried out during the doctorate in a single pdf file, signed by the Academic Commission, by the doctoral student and by the supervisor(s) and tutor (if different from the supervisor(s)).
9. If required, the opinion expressed by the Research Ethics Committee (CEI), which must be included as an appendix to the doctoral thesis.
10. [Academic Committee's endorsement and authorisation of the stay](#).
11. Original certificate(s) of stay signed by the person responsible for your stay at the institution (original signature required). This document/s must clearly state that you have stayed for at least 3 months.

12. Two positive reports on the thesis by two international experts, duly signed, clearly stating the name, institution and country (original signature required)
13. Accreditation of a B2 level in the language in which the thesis is to be defended, provided it is not their mother tongue. This rule will be compulsory for doctoral students admitted from academic year 2015-16. The official certificates accepted by the University of Alcalá can be consulted at the link to the [CRUE for language level accreditation certificates](#).

The documentation must be original, either with electronic signature or, failing that, with the original handwritten signature.
