

THESIS FORMAT IN THE FORM OF A COMPENDIUM OF PUBLICATIONS

Preamble

The regulations require that all defended theses be deposited in an institutional open access repository.

In the case of theses in the form of a compendium of publications, the inclusion of the original publications raises questions about the infringement of the publisher's copyright.

In the case of theses in the form of a compendium of publications, the inclusion of the original publications raises questions about the infringement of the publisher's copyright. However, the deposit of the thesis in this format must guarantee that the information is complete (original publications) for the defence, its archiving at the university and its submission to the relevant Ministry for inclusion in TESEO.

To ensure that the publisher's copyright is not infringed and to comply with the regulations requiring the deposit of the thesis in an open access institutional repository, the Doctoral School establishes the following format for theses consisting of a compendium of publications.

Thesis format

The author of the thesis may include publications as part of its chapters if they are in any of the following situations:

- Articles that have been published in an open access journal.
- Articles published in a subscription-based journal that have been made open access by paying a fee.
- Book chapters published in open access.
- Publications for which permission has been requested and obtained from the publisher, or where there is confirmation that such permission is not required.
- Publications for which the author has reserved the exploitation rights.

If the author has transferred the exploitation rights and the full version of the publication cannot be included, the publication will instead be included in an annex entitled "Compendium of Non-Open Access Publications", appearing at the end of the thesis. In the thesis chapters where an original publication cannot be included, it must be replaced, at a minimum, by the bibliographic reference, the abstract, the keywords and the corresponding link (URL or DOI). Additional information may be included if the author considers it appropriate and provided that this does not infringe the publisher's copyright. The University of Alcalá will exclude this annex from the document to be deposited in its open access institutional repository.
